



Dog / Puppy Adoption Application

We are pleased that you have decided to apply to adopt a dog or puppy from Baseline. Every animal adopted from Baseline has been spayed or neutered, de-flea'd/de-wormed micro-chipped and vaccinated, as required by Texas State Law.

To be considered for adoption, you must meet the following requirements-

- Be at least 23 years of age
- Have photo identification showing your present address
- Have the knowledge and consent of all adults living in the household
- Be able and willing to spend the time and money necessary to provide the training, medical treatment, and proper care of the pet
- Have the funds to pay the adoption fee at the time of the adoption (\$ 50 to \$300)
- No dogs or puppies will be adopted to families with young children unless we meet the child/ children to see how they interact with the pet
- Baseline representatives will call periodically about the health and well being of the dog or puppy
- Dogs or puppies are adopted only to homes with secure yards and / or the adopter's schedule allowing time to take the animal out "On Leash" for exercise and potty. A home check may be needed if the adopter is not sure what would be appropriately secure for each animal. Adopter AGREES to keep the pet secure either in a fenced yard or on-leash when going outside for any reason.
